Mrs. Mosley, I am genuinely sorry, and I humbly ask for your forgiveness.

My words were not consistent with how a gentleman addresses anyone, and were especially not appropriate for a City Commissioner. If Mrs. Mosley is willing to meet with me, I would like to apologize to her in person and ask how I might make amends for my behavior.

I also want to apologize to the Mayor and Anaheim City Council, who gave me the opportunity to represent the hometown I love so much, by appointing me as a member of the Cultural and Heritage Commission. I would especially like to apologize to Councilmember Barnes, who recommended me to her colleagues for the appointment to the Commission. I know her character and values are not reflected by my actions, and there is no way for me to justify my abusive language toward one of her constituents. It was wrong.

Recognizing that Anaheim deserves more civility from our Commissioners than I have displayed, I am offering my resignation from the Anaheim Cultural and Heritage Commission, effective immediately. I would like to apologize to the remaining members of the Commission, and the hard-working staff, for leaving before my term has completed. It has been an honor to serve with you.
